



Canon® C80 Z-Finder

The Zacuto C80 Z-Finder is designed to be used with the Canon C80. The Z-Finder uses a 2.5x magnification and has a diopter range of -2 to +2 with the included Extender Frames. If you need more adjustment, you can purchase drop in diopters. The interchangeable anti-fog diopters, -1, +1, +2, +3 and +4, correct the focus for perfect clarity.

The Z-Finder mounts securely to the camera strap loop, which is built into the camera's body, providing a rock solid mounting point. Attaching and removing the Z-Finder is as easy as turning a lever, flipping the latch, and sliding the Z-Finder on or off the LCD. It features foam padding so it will provide a light, tight seal and won't scratch your camera's LCD.

The unique design of the Z-Finder allows it to have a 135 degree range of motion when tilting up or down, letting you comfortably view the LCD when shooting in low mode, raised up over your head, and everything in between.

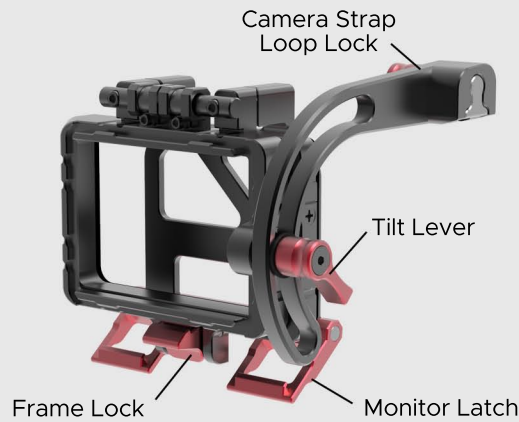
The flip open feature also gives you easy access to the LCD's touch screen for changing settings on the fly.

Assembling C80 Z-Finder

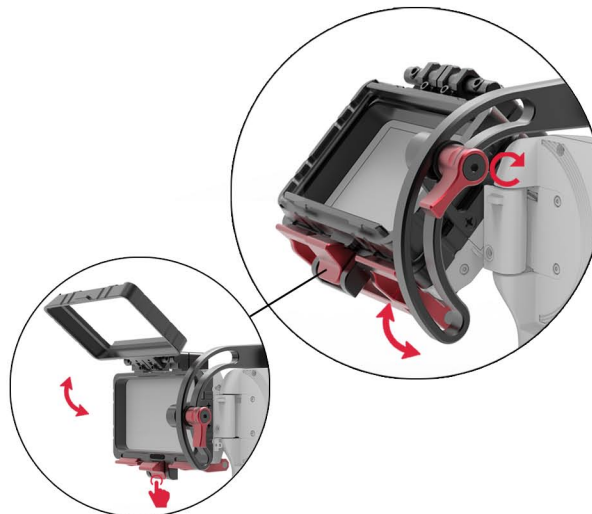
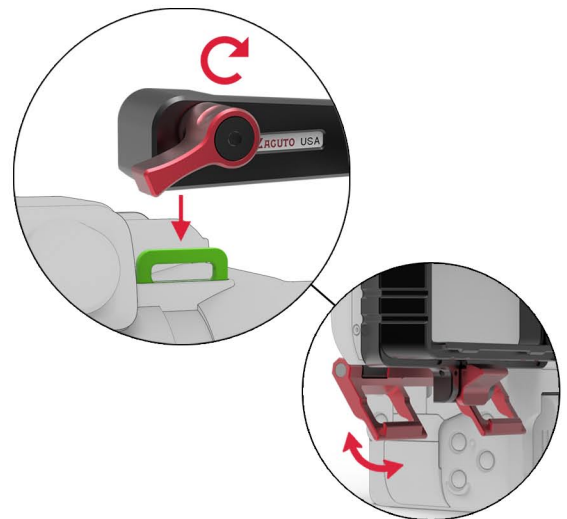
Step 1

Loosen Tilt Lever. Open LCD and orient Z-Finder frame with Monitor Latch open. Slide Z-Finder frame down onto LCD.



Step 2

Align Strap Loop Lock over camera's shoulder strap loop. Slide lock onto strap hook and tighten lever. Close Monitor Latch to secure monitor.



Step 3

Z-Finder angle can be adjusted with lever to tilt up or down. Flip open Z-Finder by pressing frame lock.



Step 4

Attach 2.5x Z-Finder.
